

COVID-19 Guidance for the Construction Workforce

- Avoid physical contact with other employees and stay at least six feet away from other employees, where possible (aka social distancing).
- If you must be within six feet of another employee, **you must wear a mask (dust mask, bandana, etc.)** over your nose and mouth **and wear goggles**, to prevent spreading the virus.
- Gloves must be worn **at all times** while working on the job site when using handheld tools or when running any type of heavy equipment.
- Do not sharing tools, equipment, phones, etc... with other employees.
- At the end of the day, wipe down any equipment and tools with disinfectant to prevent spreading the virus.
- Job trailers should be wiped down at least once per day and all employees should stay at least six feet away from each other while in the trailer. If this is not possible, then only one person at a time should be in the trailer.
- If you cough or sneeze you should cover your mouth with your arm, not your hands, to prevent spreading the virus.
- Clean your hands with soap and water often. If there is no place available that has soap and water, employees should use hand sanitizer throughout the day.
- Avoid touching your face, nose, and eyes.
- If you have a fever of 100.4 or more, do not come to work so as not to infect other employees.
- If you appear to be sick, you will be asked to go home and not return until you are well. You may be asked to have a doctor authorize your return to work.
